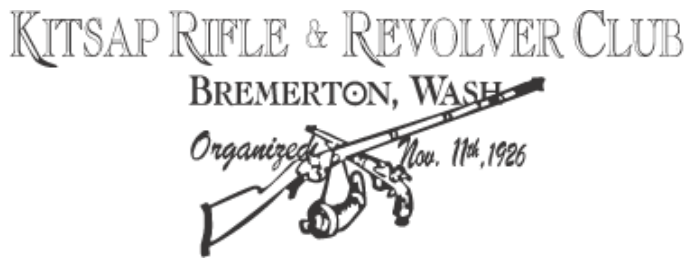

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SAFETY QUIZ (true/false):

Read each statement carefully and circle true or false.

1. When the blue “Cold Range” lights are on, it is a reminder that you are not to handle firearms. **true/false**
2. It is only important where a firearm is pointed when it is loaded. **true/false**
3. Eye and hearing protection is only required for those who are shooting. **true/false**
4. All brass cartridge casings are to be placed in the “Brass” buckets . **true/false**

6. All safety and maintenance concerns must be reported to a Range Officer immediately. **true/false**
