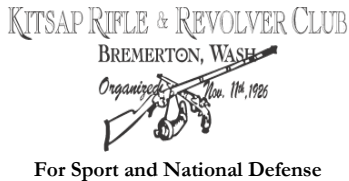

Fall Arrives at Kitsap Rifle and Revolver Club

- The Glock Shooting Sports Foundation (GSSF) held their annual all Glock handgun match at our Range on September 6th and 7th. We had 185 entrants and a great time was had by all. John Davidson was our Match Director and many members turned out to help. John Mills Jr. was winner of the Glock Pistol given, through drawing, for those that helped with the match. Winners of the match are posted on the GSSF web site. Two Glock certificates were given to the Club for hosting the event.
- Hunter's Sight-In Days, our annual event to help hunters and others get their rifles tuned up and sighted in for this season, will next be held on October 4th and 5th. The cost for EVERYONE to shoot during this event (including KRRC members) is \$5 per gun. The event runs from 9am until 3pm each day and utilizes the rifle line only. We need members help during the event. Bringing spotting scopes, basic tools and a friendly demeanor will prove out to be very handy. Please email, or call the range to sign -up if you can help during the sight-in.
- Our popular Reloading Class will be held on October 11th and will cover the fundamentals of reloading your own ammunition. Topics include: ammunition function; tool selection; set-up; component selection; case preparation; assembly; inspection and testing. If you've checked the cost of ammunition lately, you will know that this class can save you some significant cash. Space for this class is very limited, so call the range or email education@gunsafety.org for details or to sign-up. Cost is \$60 for members or \$75 for non-members. Other classes offered this month include our final Personal Protection Level 1 class for the year which will be held on October 18 and Personal Protection Level 2 class which will be held on October 19th. Both are excellent classes that will help you increase your handgun skills and could help save your life. Call the range for more details.
- Our last scheduled Work Party of the year will be held on Sunday October 12th. We plan to get the range in shape for the winter and finish up small projects that were left over from the last work party. If you haven't been to the range lately, let me tell you that it looks better than it ever has. All of the improvements are due to the efforts of our members who volunteer their time (and often equipment and supplies) in order to create a world-class range. If you have any time at all, please come out on the 12th and help continue this effort. Also, if you need to get your Participation Credits taken care of, this will be a great opportunity to do so before the end of the year.
