A big thank you to the two dozen or so members responsible for the hard work involved to grade, form, pour, finish, and place railing on the ramp. A special Thank You to Mike House, our "Man of Steel" for providing all of the steel for the ramp railings and to Dan Daniels, Ruben Vargus, Andy Casella, Theo Brundage, Ken, Del and Marcus Carter for going above and beyond in the planning and execution of the project.
- A quick safety warning: now that the windy/rainy/icy/snowy weather is upon us, be sure to take extra care when you are at the Range. All parts of the Range can be icy during inclement weather (the stairs, the ramp, the lines, the parking lot, etc) and if the weather is particularly bad, Range Officers may not be on duty. Remember to never shoot into the water or frozen over puddles in front of the lines as this can cause ricochets. Be sure to check the website for the most up-to-date news about the Range and BE SAFE!
- We are still in need of light poles to mount the new range flood lights we received a couple months ago. Most ideal would be 30' to 40' tall, however, we would not turn down ANY usable pole! If you have any leads on where we can get them, please contact a Range Officer and leave your contact information.
- The January USPSA Match has been cancelled due to inclement weather and bay renovation.
